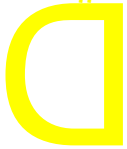




MISSION STATEMENT
