is a public polytechnic college in Lakeland, Florida. It was established in 1905 as the Polk County Normal School. In 1915 it became the Polk County Agricultural and Normal School. It became a four-year college in 1925 and was renamed the Polk County State Normal School. It became the Polk State Normal School in 1937 and the Polk State Teachers College in 1947. It became the Polk State College in 1957 and the Polk State Community College in 1968. It became Florida Polytechnic College in 1987. It offers associate degrees, bachelor's degrees, and master's degrees.
